#### Goals

The Charter School's educational program will seek to provide an opportunity for each child to develop to his or her maximum potential. The objectives for the educational program are:

1. To develop the mindsets and skills for success in college career and life;

The Charter School personnel are responsible for apprising the Board of the educational program's current and future status. The Director should prepare periodic reports that include:

1. A review and evaluation of the present curriculum;
2. A projection of curriculum and resource needs;
3. An evaluation of, and plan to eliminate, any bias that may be present in the curriculum or instructional materials and methods;
4. A plan for new or revised instructional program implementations; and
5. A review of present and future facility needs.
