New Board Members

The Palouse Prairie Charter School Board of Directors will assist newly appointed Board Members to become familiar with their duties and responsibilities as quickly as possible. All Board members are encouraged to attend appropriate workshops, seminars, and conventions in order to develop professionalism and expertise in governance.

Newly appointed Members are required by this Board policy to complete at least 4 hours of instruction on education issues, including Idaho education laws, school finance, ethics, duties, and responsibilities of Board members. The 4 hours of attendance must be accomplished during the first 12 months of the Board member's tenure. The Board and the School Director will ensure that new Members are notified of the date and time of such workshops.

Upon completion of either a new board member workshop or 4 hours of other workshops, the information will be recorded into the Board minutes.

Directors who attend and successfully complete such workshops, shall be reimbursed for actual expenses for lodging, meals, registration fees, and transportation to and from the location of the workshop as prescribed in policy 1420 "Director Expenses".

The School Director or the a designee will maintain records of each Board Member's training accomplishments and will notify any Member of the need for that person to accomplish any additional training.
