Extracurricular Transportation

The Board of Directors' primary concern in providing transportation services to students is the safety and protection of the health of students, as well as ensuring equal access to a PPCS to all students residing in the primary attendance zone.

With these goals in mind, the Board of Directors authorizes the Director to contract transportation services which best meet the needs of Palouse Prairie students and fit within the school's budget.

The Charter School shall provide transportation to and from school for a student who:

1. Is a student with a disability, or whose IEP identifies transportation as a related service.

The type of transportation provided by the Charter School may be by a school bus or other vehicle, or by such individual transportation such as paying the parent/guardian for individually transporting the student.

Homeless students shall be transported in accordance with the McKinney Homeless Assistance Act and State law.

Safety

The Director shall develop written rules establishing the procedures for bus safety and emergency exit drills, and for student conduct while riding on buses, including for students with special needs.
