

**Stakeholder Participation**

**Overview:** PPS recognizes that it is the school's role, as part of the larger community, to model and actively practice, through policies and procedures: the promotion of physical activity, nutritional, environmental, and community health.

**Wellness Committee:** The Wellness Committee shall be a diverse and inclusive working group, representative of the demographics of the school district as a whole. The members of the Wellness Committee will include: the Director(s), teachers, two students, and parents.

- In establishing the Wellness Committee, the PPS Board shall openly announce the opportunity to serve on the Committee.
- The Wellness Committee shall meet at least six times a year at hours convenient for public participation, and for sufficient time to conduct the Committee's business.
- Committee meetings will be open to all interested persons, regardless of affiliation with PPS.

**Local Designation:** The directors of Palouse Prairie School are designated as those responsible for the compliance with the Palouse Prairie School Wellness Policy.
