TITLE ONE/INTERVENTION IDENTIFICATION

Istation

- The Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI) is provided by Istation. It is administered to K-3 students n the Fall and Spring. Advanced Reading 4-5.
- IRI is used as a screener for dyslexia and reading difficulties. The results go directly to the State Department of Education.
- This is a nationally normed reading program that automatically adjusts to the child's skill level as they progress through the program.
- The Istation assessment measures multiple areas within the six foundational reading skills:
 - Alphabetic decoding
 - Spelling
 - Phonemic awareness
 - Vocabulary
 - Comprehension
 - Fluency

Teacher Recommendation during MTSS and "fiesta" meetings

Multi Tiered System of Support (MTSS)

- Based on screening results and teacher recommendations students are selected for tier (2/3) intervention groups.
- 3 MTSS meetings per school year after whole school data dive (Celeste, Ingrid, Sara, Teacher) October/January/April
- Fiesta meetings | X per month. (Celeste, Ingrid, Teacher)
- Parents are notified in October if students are receiving intervention
- Tier I in classroom, Tier 2 in classroom, Tier 2 pull out, Tier 3 pull out
- Groups are organic and fluid
- 4 x per week for at least 30 minutes

 - Students are assessed monthly
 - After the assessment is complete the program continues to provide specific lessons based on the skill level of the student
 - The teachers have access to this information and can plan for interventions based on what reading skill is needed
- Formative Assessments in the classroom
- Teacher Observations
